NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2009-12, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the rules of the CFJ class, and this Notice of Race (accept as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY

This event is open to all high school teams. Multiple teams per school are welcome. A fee of \$5 per competitor will be charged during registration. Entry fee includes a BBQ lunch. Checks can be made out to "Sail Sand Point". Schools may "mix and match" sailors to form full teams, this is an "Open" event.

BOATS

Sail Sand Point will provide 14 FJ's for this event. Any teams who can bring additional FJ's are encouraged to do so. Entry will be limited to 14 schools unless more teams can bring boats. Contact Alex Jones if you can bring boats.
