1. RULES:

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. The regatta is classified as a Category A event with respect to Advertising.

1.2 RRS Appendix P will be in effect modified as follows: Delete the word "first" in rule P2.1. Delete rules P2.2 and 2.3. Delete rule P3 and replace it with: "If a boat has been protested under rule P1 in a race and the race committee signals a postponement, general recall, or abandonment of that race, the penalty is cancelled."

2. ELIGIBILITY:

2.1 Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.

2.2 Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.

3. ENTRY

3.1 Eligible schools and sailors must enter by submitting an [official entry form](#) and check, by 1000 Saturday, October 20, 2007.

4. ENTRY FEE:

4.1 The entry is \$20 per competitor, This includes dinner Saturday, additional dinner tickets may be purchased at \$10 each.

1500 No warning signal after this time.

1400 Trophy Presentation

Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board located at CYC Clubhouse.

6. RACING AREA:

All races will be sailed on Shilshole Bay, just outside the Shilshole Bay Marina breakwater.

7. COURSES:

Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA Procedural Rule 7.7.

8. SCORING:

The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

9. WATER TEMPERATURE

Puget Sound is cold. Competitors are strongly urged to come equipped with a wet suit or a dry suit and to bring warm clothes.

14. COACHING:

Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area on October 20 or 21 unless explicitly permitted to do so by the regatta chairperson. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

15. PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded to schools placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class in the regatta. .

16. OFFICIAL NOTICE:

No competitor shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which by that competitor is unlawful under 21 US Code 841. An alleged breach of this regulation and/or other discipline expectations occurring during October 26, 27 or 28, 2007 may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1 The protest committee for such a hearing shall be the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA BOD, and the protest committee chairperson.
