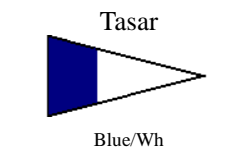
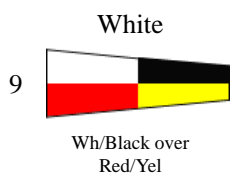
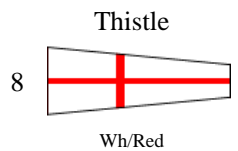
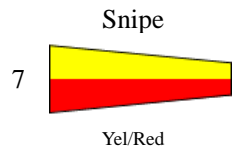
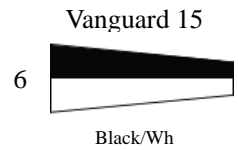
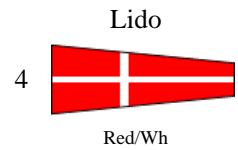
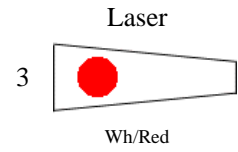


RACE SIGNALS

Class Flags

May be substituted with flag bearing class logo



Starting Sequence

A 3-minute sequence will be used as follows.

Warning	Class Flag; 1 sound	3min
Preparatory	Code Flag P is raised; 1 sound	2min
One-Minute	Code Flag P is lowered; 1 long sound	1min
Starting	Class Flag removed*; 1 sound	0min

*succeeding class flag will be raised at the start of preceding class to give a 3-minute sequence

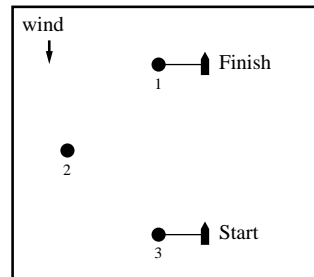

- Sail the Buoys in Parentheses According to Numeral Displayed on Course Board

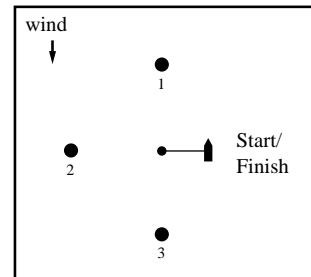

Course layout: T, W, O



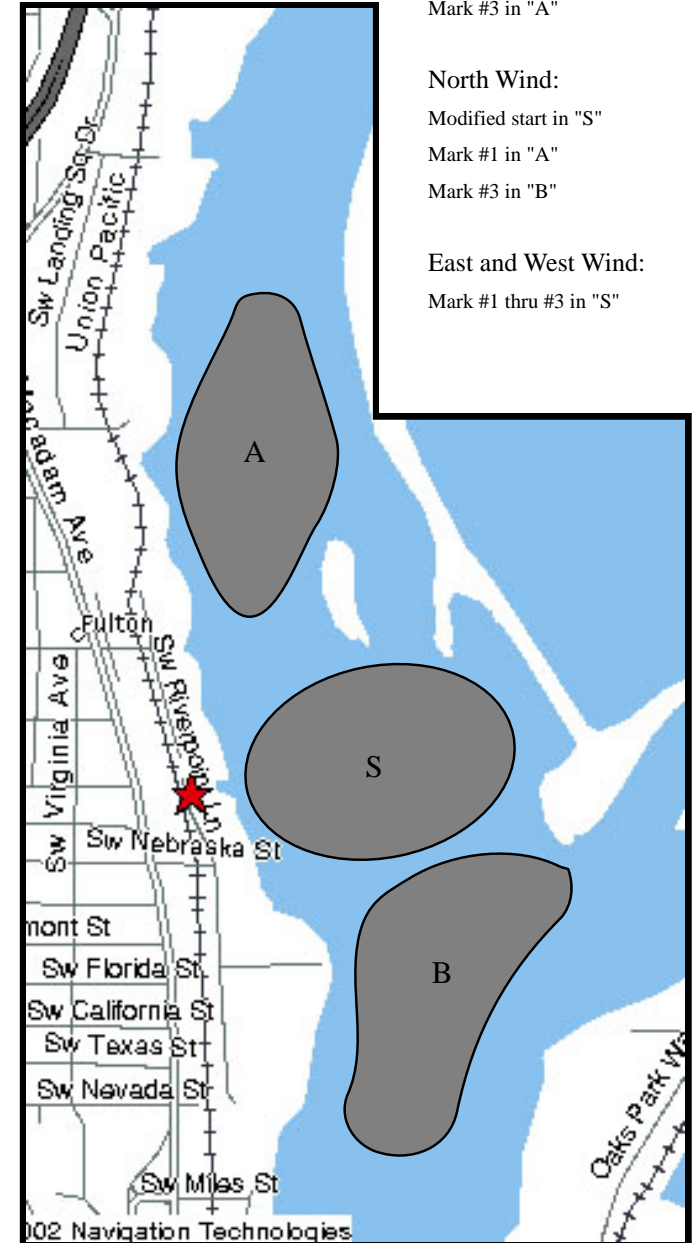
Course layout: TM, WM, OM

- Mark #3 in "B"

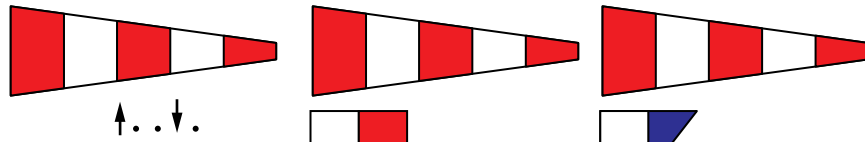
East and West Wind:

RACE SIGNALS

The meanings of visual and sound signals are stated below. An arrow pointing up or down (↑ ↓) means that a visual signal is displayed or removed. A dot (•) means a sound; dots with dashes (•- - - •) mean repetitive sounds. When a visual signal is displayed over a class flag, the signal applies only to that class.

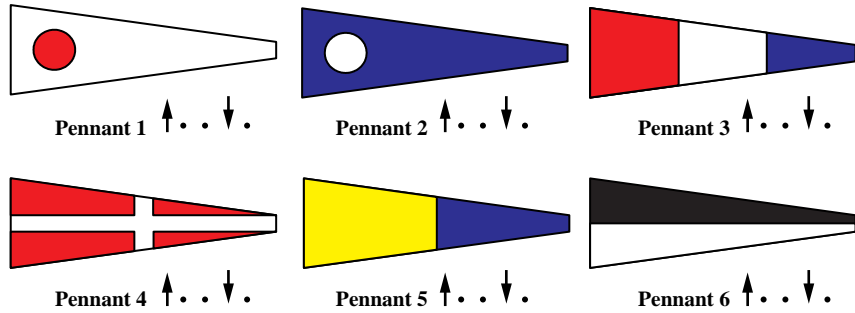
Postponement Signals



AP Races not started are *postponed*. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is *postponed* again or *abandoned*.

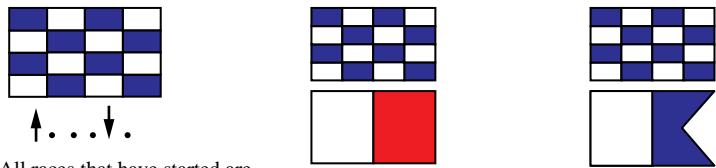
AP over H Races not started are *postponed*. Further signals ashore.

AP over A Races not started are *postponed*. No more racing today.



AP over a numeral pennant 1–6 *Postponement* of 1–6 hours from the scheduled starting time.

Abandonment Signals



N All races that have started are *abandoned*. Return to the starting area. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is

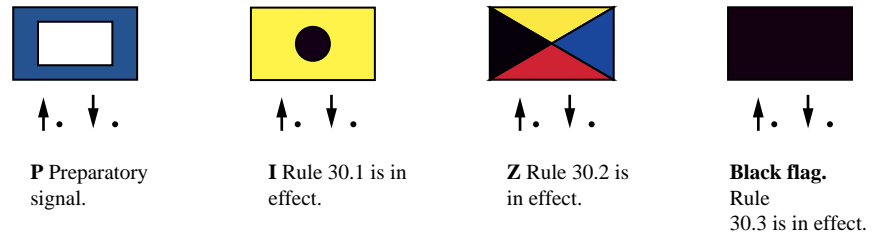
N over H All races are *abandoned*. Further signals ashore.

N over A All races are *abandoned*. No more racing today.

Commercial Traffic:

- All yachts must give right of way to commercial and government vessels.
- No yacht shall pass between a leading WSC committee boat and such traffic while leading the traffic.
- Committee boats leading such traffic will be a reasonable distance ahead of the traffic in order for the operator to see the WSC boat.

Signals Before the Start



P Preparatory signal.

I Rule 30.1 is in effect.

Z Rule 30.2 is in effect.

Black flag. Rule 30.3 is in effect.

Recall Signals



X Individual recall.

First Substitute General recall. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal.

Course Change Signals



S No later than the warning signal: Sail the short course.
At a rounding or finishing mark: Finish between the nearby mark and the staff displaying this flag.

C The position of the next mark has been changed.

Other Signals



L Ashore: A notice to competitors has been posted.

M The object displaying this signal replaces a mark.

Y Wear personal buoyancy.

Blue flag or shape. This race committee boat is in position at the finishing line.

Afloat: Come within hail or follow this boat.

•Four sounds will announce the presence of commercial or large vessels that will pass through the racecourse. A yacht may use any means of propulsion to clear the hazard provided that:

- The yacht did not improve its position by using other means of propulsion and,
- A written explanation is provided to the race committee within 30 minutes of the last yacht completing the last race of the day.
