Notice of Race
Willamette Sailing Club
Rose Festival Youth Regatta
Sunday, June 1, 2008
Portland, Oregon

You are invited to participate in the 2008 Willamette Sailing Club Rose Festival Youth Regatta, sponsored by the Willamette Sailing Club and Sanctioned by the Portland Rose Festival Association.

Location: Sunday, June 1, 2008, racing held at the downtown waterfront as part of the Portland Rose Festival, the largest civic celebration in Portland.

Eligibility: This regatta is a special invitational event open to all high school students, plus Opti sailors age 8 and older. For the 2008 regatta, adult racing fleets will be welcome by special arrangement.

For two-hand competition each school may enter only one complete team; however teams representing combinations of school clubs will be allowed. Sailors may also compete individually in Lasers or Laser Radials. The list of competitors must be submitted to the race committee prior to the skippers' meeting. The competitors in the high school events must be in the 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade as of the date of the regatta. An adult representative must accompany each team and be responsible for their conduct on and off the water. These representatives will be expected to have full written authority to seek emergency medical treatment for any member of their team.

Opti racing for youth 8 and older will be offered if three or more Opti racers attend.

Classes: Opti, Laser, Laser Radial, and Club 420.

Authority: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, 2005-2008, by the *Procedural Rules for Interscholastic Sailing Competition*, Spring 2005-Fall 2008 (for high school sailing), by the sailing instructions, and this Notice of Race.

Registration: Pre-registration or a simple RSVP is appreciated. To obtain pre-registration forms, contact Michael Rees, commodore@willamettesailingclub.com, or check <http://www.willamettesailingclub.com/youthregatta/> Competitors will be required to execute a recreational liability waiver.

Fees: Registration fees are \$10 per person.

Meals: Box lunches provided Sunday.

Spectator Accommodations: In downtown Portland, the race course will be visible from various overlooks on both sides of the river. There will be a Willamette Sailing Club information booth at the 5-Flags area in front of the River Place Hotel.

Directions to WSC:*From I5 South*

Take exit 299A (Lake Oswego/Macadam Ave.). Once on the off ramp, merge to one of the right 2 lanes (otherwise you will end up back on I5 South). This will dump you down onto Macadam Ave. Continue South until you see the Pacific Pride gas station on your left. Get in the left hand turn lane at the Pacific Pride gas station. It may not look like a road, but when you turn you'll see the masts ahead (this is actually SW Carolina Street).

From I5 North

Take exit 298 (Corbett) and turn right at the bottom of the off ramp. Go to the stop sign (this is Boundary) and turn left. GO to the stoplight and turn right. You are now on Macadam Ave. Go until you see the Pacific Pride gas station on the left. Get in the left hand turn lane at the Pacific Pride gas station. It may not look like a road, but when you turn you'll see the masts ahead (this is actually SW Carolina Street).
