





























RACE SIGNALS

	Flag Signal	Sound signal when raised	Sound signal when lowered	Description
General Signals				Come within Hail Ashore: A notice to competitors has been posted. On the water: Come within hail or follow this boat.
				Postponement Races not yet started are postponed.
				Abandonment All races are abandoned.
Starting Signals				Warning (3-minute) Warning signal for the class whose insignia is displayed. This class will start in 3 minutes. Lowered at start.
				Preparatory (2-minute) Preparatory signal. Race will start in 2 minutes. Lowered at 1-minute signal.
				Preparatory (round-the-ends rule) Same as P Flag except Rule 30.1 is in effect (boats over the line must round an end prior to starting).
				Individual Recall One or more boats are recalled because they were on course side of line at starting signal or must comply with rule 30.1.
				General Recall All boats are recalled for a new start because of unidentified boats on course side of the line or error in starting procedure.
Course Change Signals				Shorten Course Finish between the nearby mark and the staff displaying this flag.
		 (repeated)		Change Course The position of the next mark has been changed.
		 (repeated)		New Mark The object displaying this flag replaces a missing mark.
