

**WSC Spring Youth Regatta
Willamette Sailing Club, May 19, 2012**

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

The WSC Spring Youth Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009-2012. Any rule modifications will appear on the official notice board inside the clubhouse, and be announced at the skippers meeting.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

Entrants must be 18 yrs of age or younger as of May 19, 2012.

3. FEES & ENTRY:

\$7 per sailor will cover the cost of food and trophies.

4. CLASSES:

Classes will be Collegiate 420 (no spins or traps), Laser Radial, and optimist. Other classes will be admitted if they are able to field at least 2 boats.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

10:30am Competitor's Meeting

11:00am First Start

12:00pm Lunch Break (time approximate)

3:00pm Last possible start

4:00pm Cookout and awards

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Will be available at WSC on May 19 and posted on the official notice board inside the WSC clubhouse.

7. SCORING:

A minimum of one race must be completed for the event to be official; there will be no maximum to the number of races. There will be one discard for every 6 races completed.

8. SAFETY:

A Coast Guard approved Type 3 jacket must be properly worn by all competitors at all times when on the water during the event.

9. PRIZES:

Sailors in the Collegiate 420 class will be competing for the 2012 Willamette Sailing Club Youth Double-Handed Championship. Only WSC members are eligible to win the championship. Sailors in Opti and Laser classes will earn awards.
